

**Suggested Course Sequence for Students
in School Health Education (Undergraduate)
Beginning AY 2007-2008**

These suggested schedules are based on a student's having previously completed all of his or her lower division general education course work, plus all lower division health science program prerequisites* (according to the 2007-2008 CSUSB Bulletin) for entry into the School Health Education concentration with "junior" standing.

Any variation from this suggested guide may result in the student's not being able to complete his or her degree on schedule.
