The Department of Health Science & Human Ecology, California State University, San Bernardino is accepting applications for a tenure-track position as assistant professor in health care management and public health.

California State University, San Bernardino (a Hispanic serving Institution) is located in San Bernardino in the Inland Empire, 60 miles East from Los Angeles. CSUSB offers programs through the colleges of Arts and Letters, Business and Public Administration, Education, Natural Sciences, Social and Behavioral Sciences and operates a satellite campus in Palm Desert located in Coachella Valley. CSUSB serves approximately 20,700 students and offers 47 undergraduate, 35 graduate and one doctoral degree as well as 13 programs with national accreditation.

CSUSB actively encourages qualified applicants to apply who demonstrate a commitment to serving a diverse student population and advancing student success through highly engaged, high impact educational practices. We are particularly interested in receiving applications from women and members of historically underrepresented groups.

TYPICAL ACTIVITIES:

Teaching responsibilities could include undergraduate and/or graduate courses in healthcare management and public health, with emphasis on core courses such as biostatistics, research methods, grant writing, epidemiology, and health economics/financial systems. The appointee will be expected to advise undergraduate and graduate students, as well as supervise undergraduate and graduate student research projects. The successful candidate will be expected to demonstrate the following:

1. University-level teaching effectiveness in the areas of health care management and public health, with emphasis on core courses such as biostatistics, research methods, grant writing, epidemiology, and health economics/financial systems.
2. Experience in and commitment to teaching, learning, scholarship, collaboration, and potential for mentoring that includes interdisciplinary collaboration, social justice, multicultural, and global perspectives and applications.
3. Ability to design, teach, and evaluate graduate and undergraduate courses in traditional, online, and hybrid formats.
4. Ability to contribute to the development, maintenance, and continued accreditation as well as quarter-to-semester conversion/transformation of departmental programs.
5. Record of peer-reviewed publications/presentations and potential for obtaining grants and external funding.

6. Membership, active participation, and demonstrated potential for leadership in professional organizations.
7. Professional experience in settings outside of academia, such as, agencies or institutions related to healthcare/public health professions.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

The successful candidate must possess a doctoral degree from an accredited institution in health care management, public health, or a closely related discipline. ABD candidates will be considered but the terminal degree must be received by the appointment date.

SALARY: Dependent on qualifications and experience.

1. A letter of interest: highlight key skills and accomplishments relevant to the job descriptions.
2. Statement of teaching philosophy and strategies.
3. A Diversity Statement: this may include your interpretation of diversity, inclusion, gender equity and specific examples of how your educational and/or professional experiences, background/philosophy has prepared you for this role at California State University, San Bernardino (maximum 250 words).
4. A curriculum vitae
5. A statement of research accomplishments and goals.
6. Three letters of recommendation on letter head with contact information of references included.
7. Sample peer-reviewed publication or scholarly presentation.
8. Documentation to support teaching effectiveness.
9. Documentation to support service to community, profession, and/or University.
10. Undergraduate and graduate transcripts (official transcripts will be required pending an offer).

Review of applications will begin December 15, 2017 and the position will remain open until filled.
